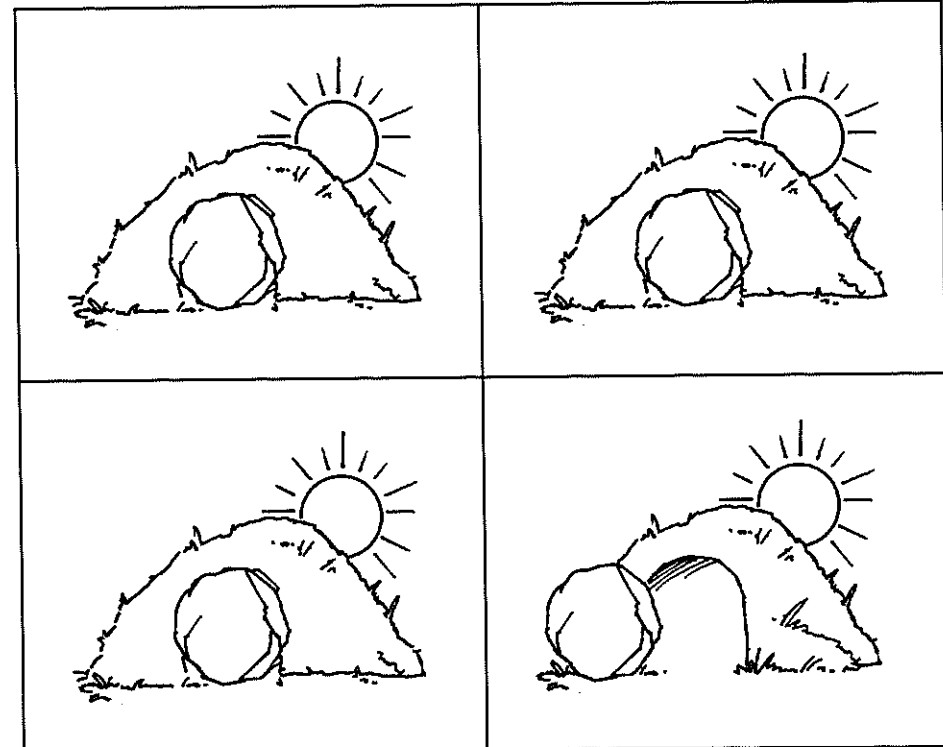

Jesus Appears to Mary Magdalene

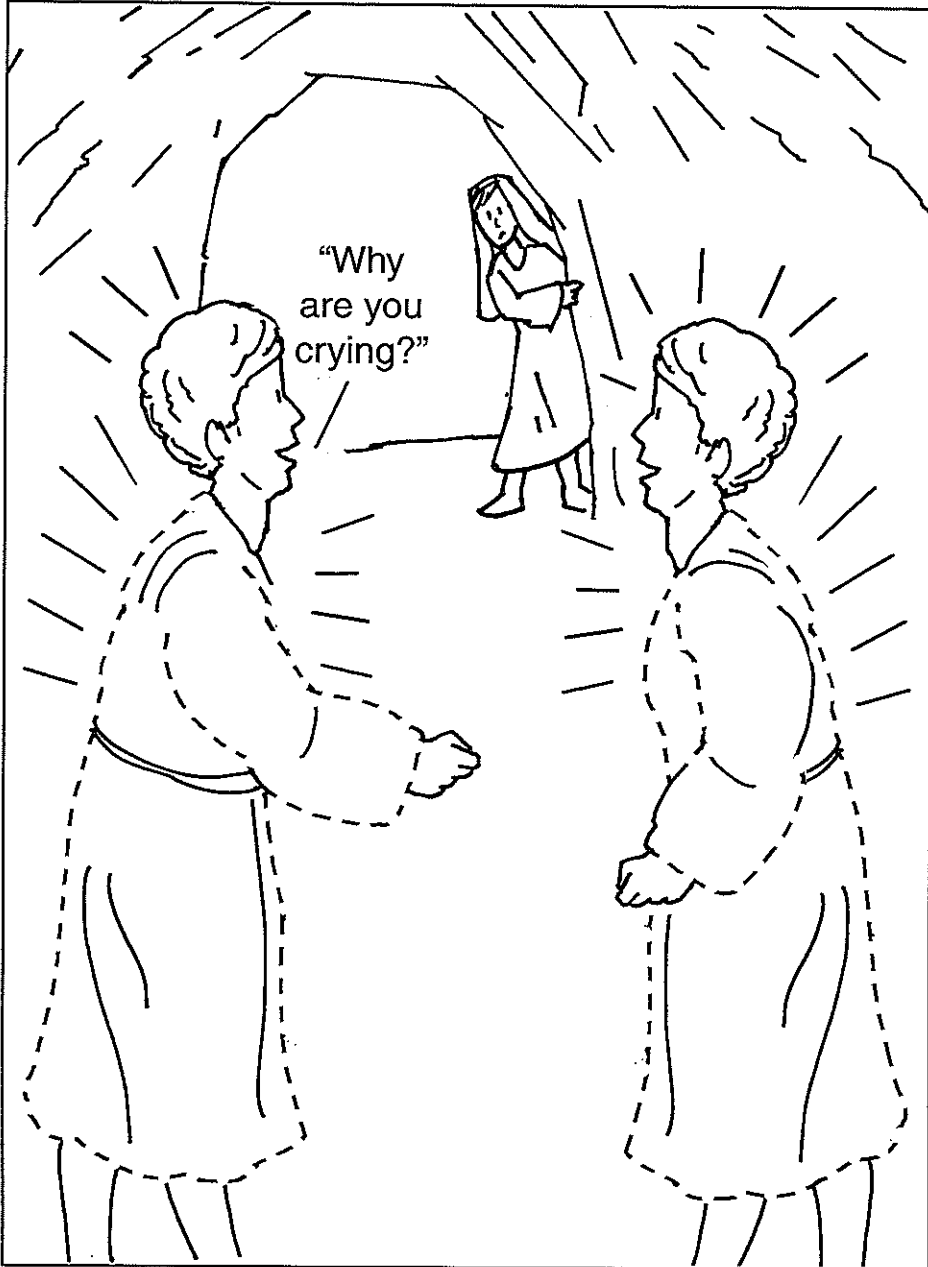
Mary Magdalene, Simon Peter and another

Circle the picture that is different.



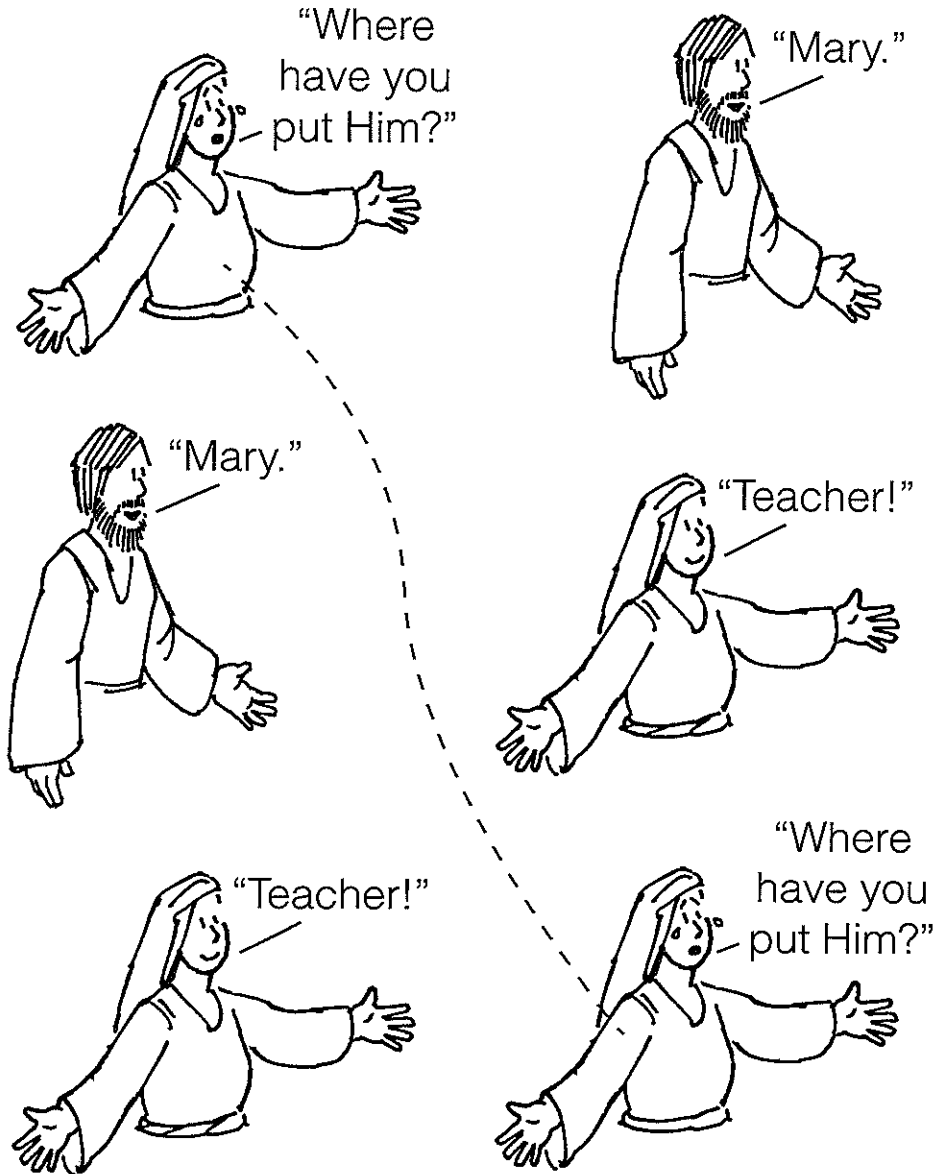
As Mary stood outside the tomb crying, 2 angels appeared.

Then Jesus appeared to Mary. She thought He was the gardener. Then Jesus spoke. Mary knew it was Jesus.

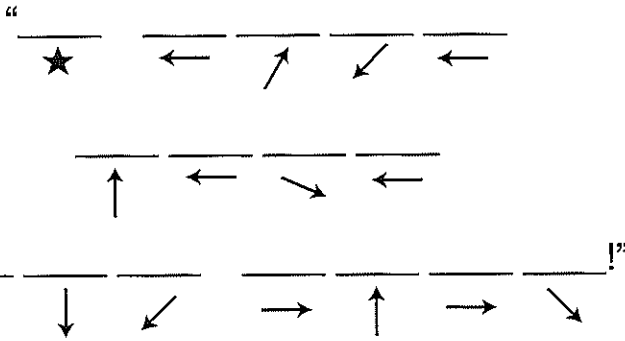
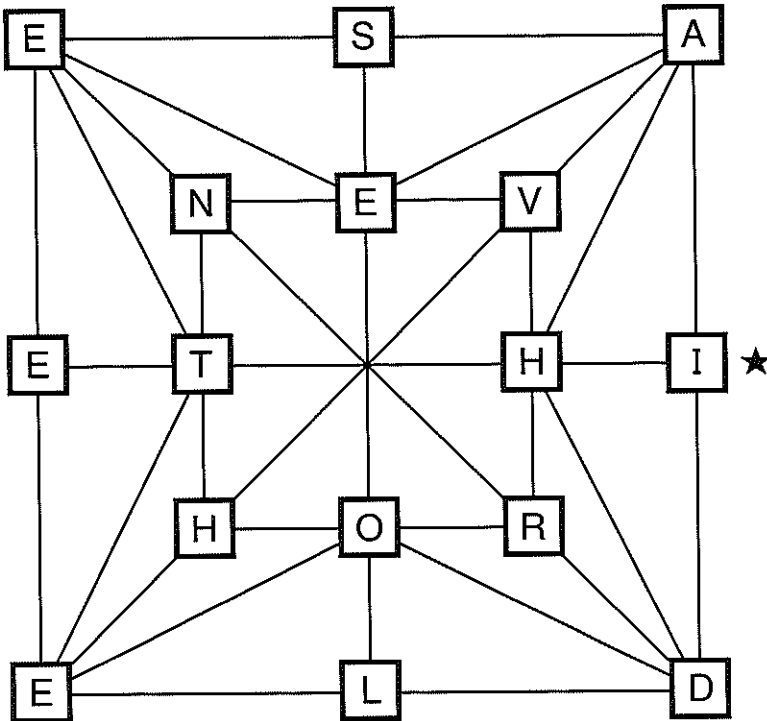
