Join Diana Thomas and family as they celebrate the life of Hazel H. Dale on Saturday, June 18th at 11:00am. Visitation will follow service.

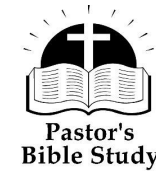
