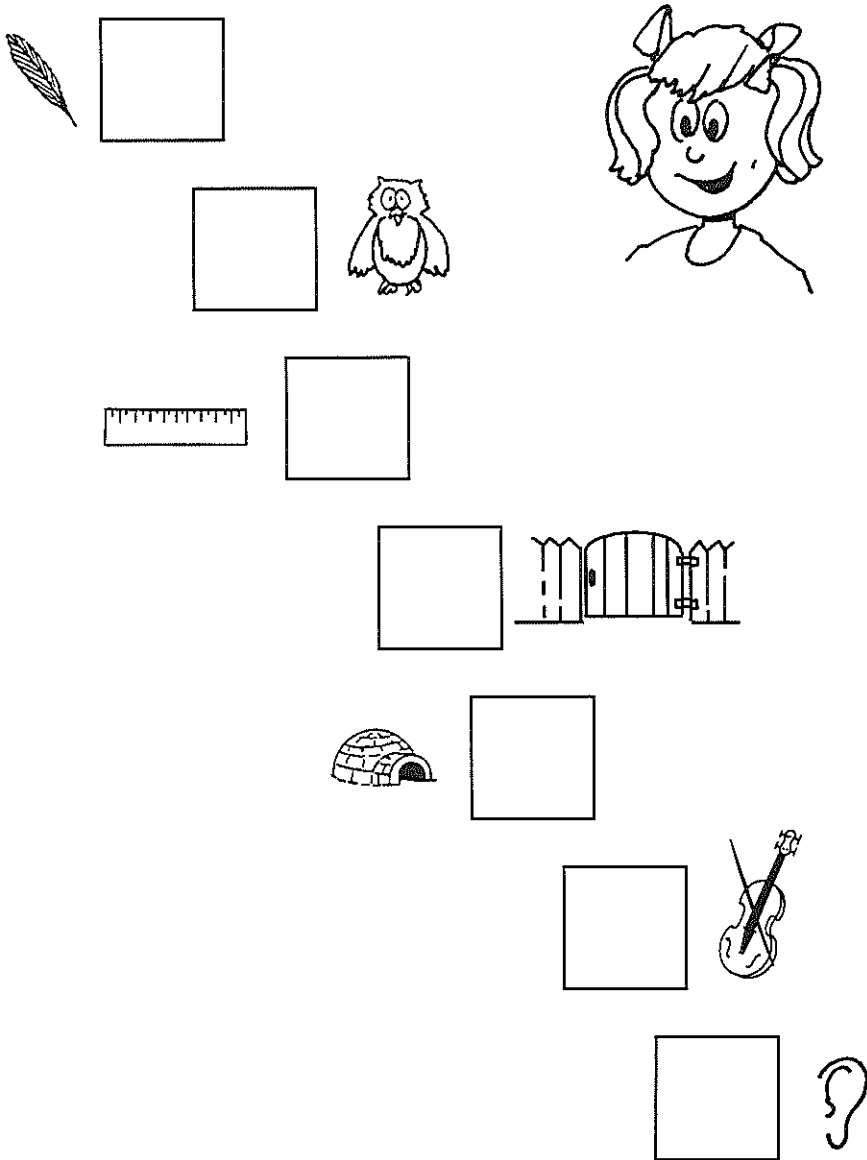

The Parable of the Unmerciful Servant

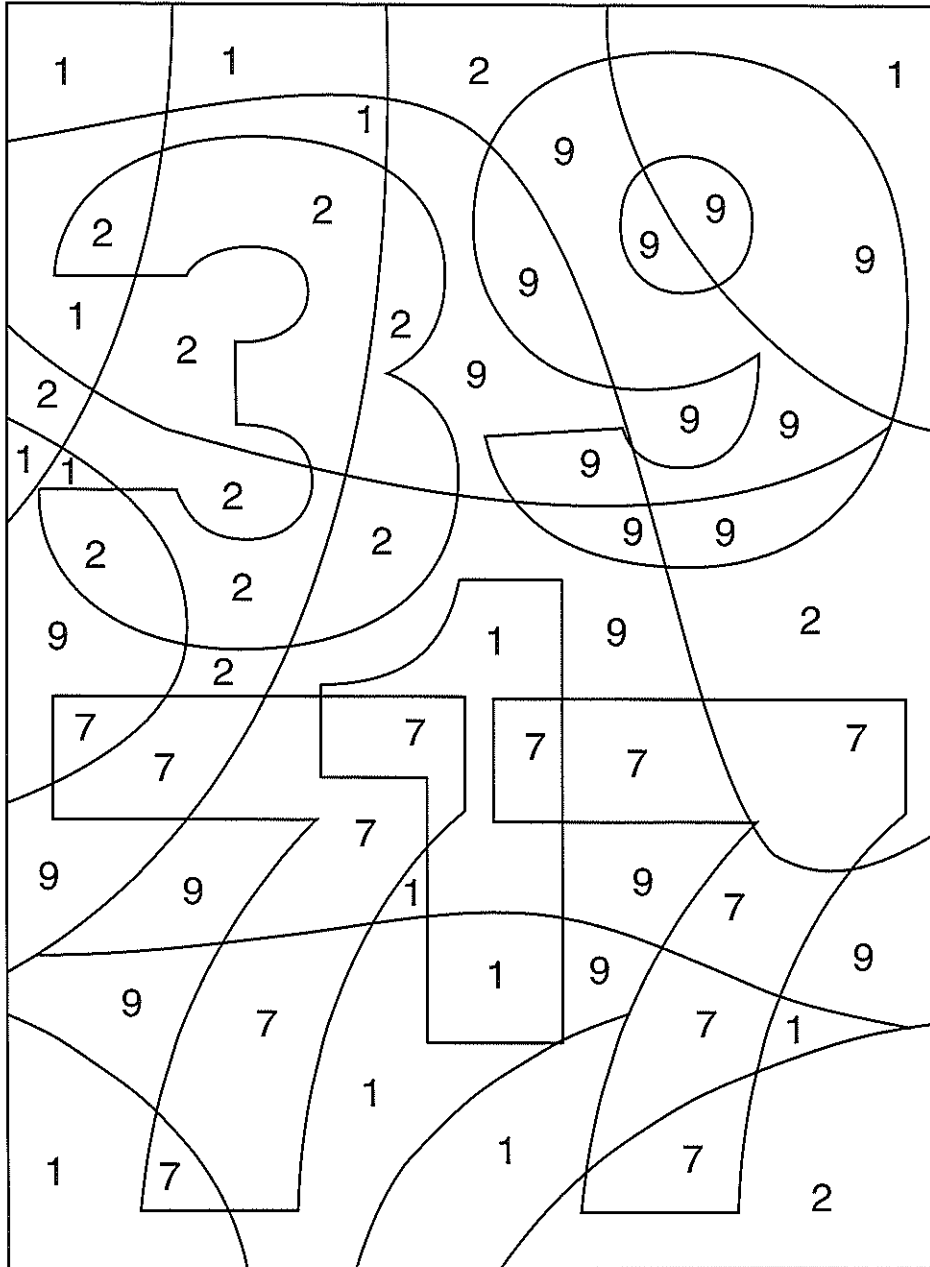
Peter asked Jesus,

Find 7 “7’s” in the picture.



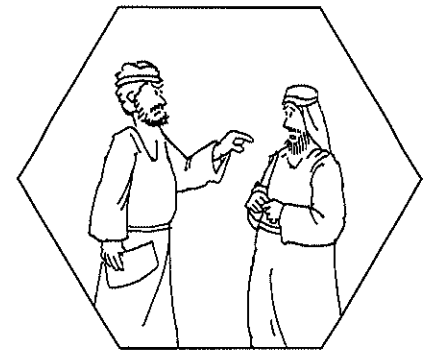
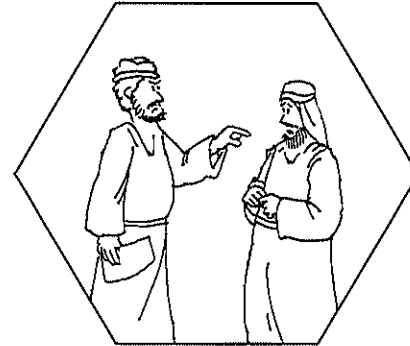
Jesus replied,

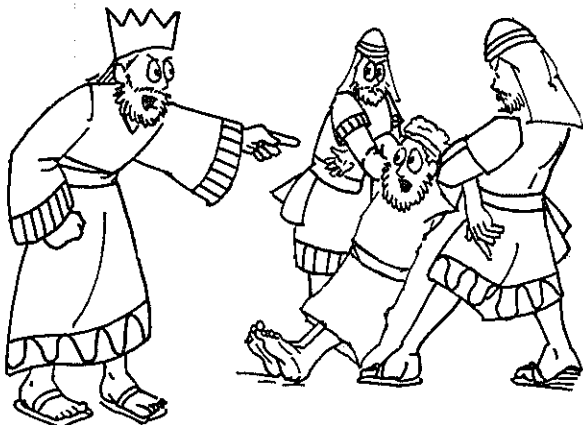
